

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Pastor-Parish Relations Committee (a.k.a PPR)

The Pastor Parish Relations Committee (PPR) is the personnel committee of the church. It is a 9-lay committee whose job duties are to oversee the professional staff of the church. This committee represents Human Relations Issues (HR). PPR Chair for 2013 is Dennis Fox.

Board of Trustees (a.k.a Trustees)

The Board of Trustees is a 9-member lay committee whose job duties are to oversee the physical assets, plant and property of the church. Trustees Chair for 2013 is Jon Burks.

Nominations Committee (a.k.a Nominations)

The Committee on Nominations is a 9-member lay committee, Chaired by the Senior Pastor of the church who has voting privileges. This committee makes recommendation to the Church Council and Charge Conference for Disciple Leadership in the various lay committee membership.

Finance Committee (a.k.a Finance)

The Finance Committee is a lay committee made up of the duly elected lay leadership committee Chairs. This committee functions to oversee the financial operations of Christ Church, with responsibility to develop ministry budgets and secure funds for the budgets. Finance Chair for 2013 is Ray Mentzer.

Budget Review Committee (a.k.a BRC)

The Budget Review Committee, is a subcommittee of the Finance Committee, made up of lay disciple servants who have expertise in multi-million dollar Balance Sheet and financial reporting for Non-profit Corporations. Its job duty is to review monthly the Financial Statements and Balance Sheet of the Church for reporting to the Finance Committee. BRC Chair for 2013 is Ray Mentzer.

Church Council (a.k.a Council)

The Church Council is the lead administrative committee of the church whose job duty is to carry out the goals, directives and plans of the Charge Conference of the Church. It is a Disciple servant committee made up of all Committee Chairs, Lay Delegates to Annual Conference, Lay Leader, and Clergy. Council Chair for 2013 is Stoney Burke.

Charge Conference

The annual meeting of the Charge Conference is the Executive Committee of the Church. It represents the Annual Meeting of Texas Not-For-Profit Corporation (d.b.a. *Christ Church United Methodist, The Woodlands, Texas*) whose job duty is to set all goals and objectives of Christ Church United Methodist. The Charge Conference is unique to the United Methodist Church, it consists of the District Superintendent as Chair over the Church Council. Charge Conference can only be called into session with the consist of the Senior Pastor and District Superintendent.
